Mooseheart's Centennial Celebration July 27 Will Mark 100 Years of Giving Hope to Kids in Need

Ever since its dedication on July 27, 1913, Mooseheart Child City and School has given a home, education and stability to more than 12,000 children from across the continent, and the world.

Exactly 100 years later—Saturday, July 27, 2013—will be an all-day celebration of Mooseheart's mission and successes, as thousands of Moose members, Mooseheart alumni and members of the community will mark the history and the future of the community, with a 100-minute fun run, hours of free live entertainment, a carnival, food and beverage tents, fireworks at dusk—and by breaking ground on a \$10 million renovation project of Mooseheart School. From 9am through until after dark, it's the Mooseheart Centennial Celebration.

"The bottom line is Mooseheart would not exist if it wasn't for the ongoing support and generosity of the men and women of the Moose," said Mooseheart Executive Director Gary Urwiler. "We are looking forward to celebrating the grand occasion with our Moose members and Mooseheart students, and kicking off the next 100 years of service to children of need."

A rededication ceremony for Mooseheart, honoring Mooseheart founder James J. Davis and first Superintendent Rodney Brandon, and featuring remarks from former U.S. House Speaker Dennis Hastert, will highlight festivities at 11am. Preceding, at 9am, will be the 100-minute Centennial Challenge Walk/Run; and following throughout the afternoon will be a full carnival and pony rides, musical entertainment throughout the day including Rick K and the Allnighters and the Beatles tribute band "American English," food/beer/soft drink tents, a petting zoo, a groundbreaking ceremony for the Mooseheart School renovation, and at dusk, a spectacular fireworks display.

SPONSOR 2 FREE DUES FOR YOU!



To help you invite qualified friends and relatives into our Fraternity, the Supreme Council and Grand Council have authorized the General Governor to waive all application fees for the entire fiscal year. That's right - \$0 application fees all year long from May 1, 2013 – April 30, 2014! This applies to all Loyal Order of Moose, Women of the Moose and Moose Legion applications. There is no longer a reason to wait to bring new members into our fraternity.

100 YEARS

For all members who sponsor at least one individual into the Fraternity, Moose – G0 THE DISTANCE lapel recognition pins will once again be available through all lodges that request them. All chapters and Moose Legion units will automatically be supplied with pins for distribution.

When a member's first two applications are reported and enrolled during this campaign year, he/she will once again qualify for a year's free dues in his/her primary lodge or chapter. Life Members that sponsor two applications will receive a \$15 gift certificate for the Moose Catalog Sales Store.

For each member that qualifies for the 5 Club, \$5 will be donated to the Mooseheart School Renovation project courtesy of your state association, the Women of the Moose and the Moose Legion. We are asking each association to use an additional \$5, which has traditionally been collected to ship award items, as seed money to start a local campaign to help promote membership.

Members sponsoring 25 or more during the campaign will qualify for the Circle of Distinction, Heart of Distinction or Moose Legionnaire of Distinction award and have a Centennial Mooseheart Brick dedicated to them during the renovation project. Other incentives are also available depending upon the level achieved, including a free trip to next year's Las Vegas Convention for those signing and enrolling 100 or more members.

A commemorative Moose membership card will be printed for any new or renewed membership that occurs from May 1, 2013 through April 30th, 2014. The cards are gold in color and feature the Mooseheart Centennial Logo in the lower left corner. All other information on the card is exactly the same as before. Both the existing green membership card and the new gold card should be honored at all lodges, assuming the "paid to" date in the lower right corner is current! Cards that are not typically replaced annually (paid in advance, life members, etc.) will not be sent a new card, but can receive one for a small donation to the Mooseheart Renovation Project at the Membership Department display at convention or by contacting the Member Services team by phone any time after June 1st (630-906-3658).

Moose – G0 THE DISTANCE campaign merchandise will be available beginning Friday, May 24th at the Milwaukee Convention and through catalog sales after the close of the meeting.
